**“A Common World – Sharing best practices on intercultural
education”**

During December 2007 the cd-rom “A Common World – Sharing best practices on intercultural education” will be ready for distribution to youth associations, NGOs, schools, local authorities.

The cd-rom “A Common World – Sharing best practices on intercultural education” is the result of its namesake project supported by the European Commission in the frame of the Youth Programme Action 5. The project lasted 12 months from December 2006 until November 2007.

The general aim of the project was to enable the exchange of good practices on intercultural education targeted at young people among NGOs working in the field of non formal youth education from Europe, Africa, Latin America and Asia.

During the implementation period, an international training course was organised for youth workers working with young people in a multicultural environment and using the non-formal education methodology. The results of the course are published in the cd-rom.

Other activities implemented in the project have been two international partners’ meetings organised in Greece and in Mozambique with the aim, among others, to share information among partner organisations on youth work and youth policies in the countries participating in the project, to share experiences on non formal education activities with young people, and to identify and exchange best practices on intercultural education activities among partner organisations.

The basic elements of intercultural education and the activities developed by partner’s organisations form the content of the cd-rom.

The cd-rom is aimed at youth workers, who like to use intercultural education and its manifold activities as working methods in their projects with young people in a multicultural environment.
